- To improve our understanding of the speed skating community in Canada.
- To better inform growth initiatives, program development and policy development.
- To remove any unnecessary questions.

Information Gathered

Key points

Please note the following key points:

- The SSC portion of the membership registration form in IceReg no longer requires registrants to identify their **sex**. Instead, registrants are requested to identify their **gender identity**.
- The SSC portion of the membership registration form in IceReg no longer includes a standalone question asking registrants to identify as an indigenous person. The option to identify as an indigenous person is now available within a broader demographic question.

Considerations

- At a Provincial / Territorial Sport Organization’s (PTSO) discretion, additional questions can be added to the PTSO portion of the membership registration form in IceReg. Note questions added by a PTSO will only be visible to registrants purchasing that PTSO’s membership(s).

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- Questions regarding a registrant's sex assigned at birth may be added within an organization's event registration process, when appropriate.
 - Moving forward, SSC will continue to seek out and provide guidance on requesting and tracking information on sex and gender.
